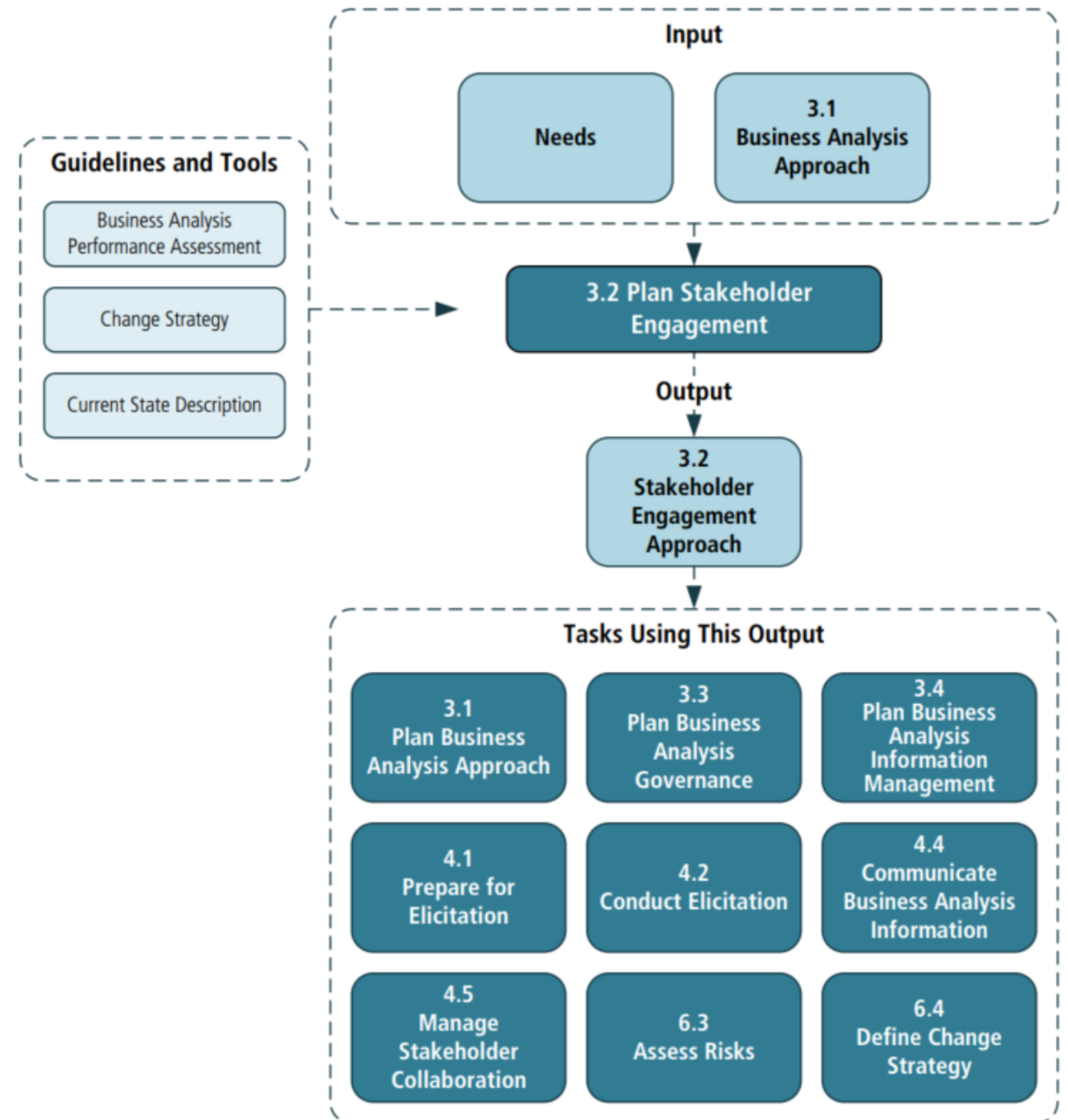
Input/Output Diagram



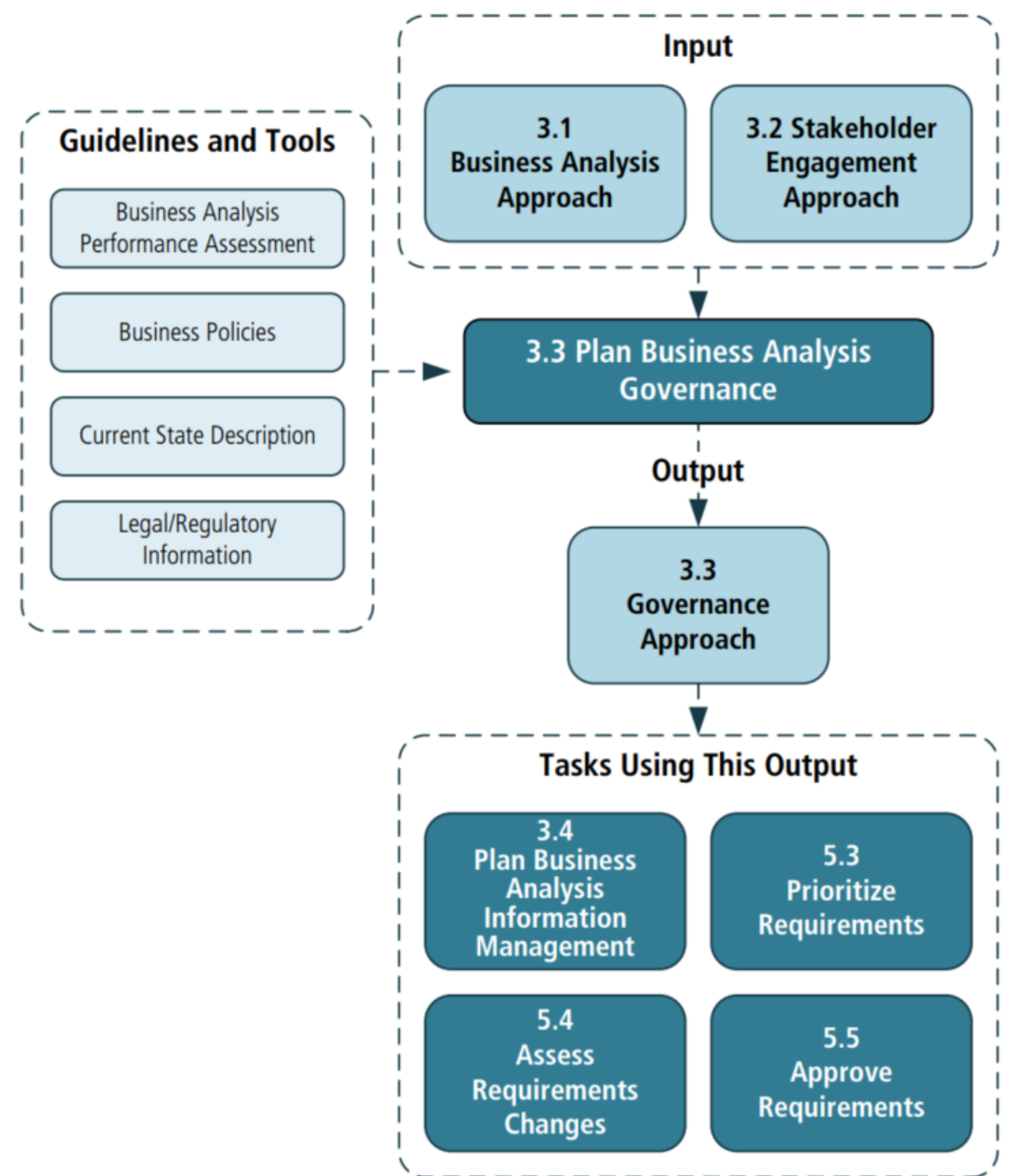
Plan Business Analysis Approach Input/Output Diagram



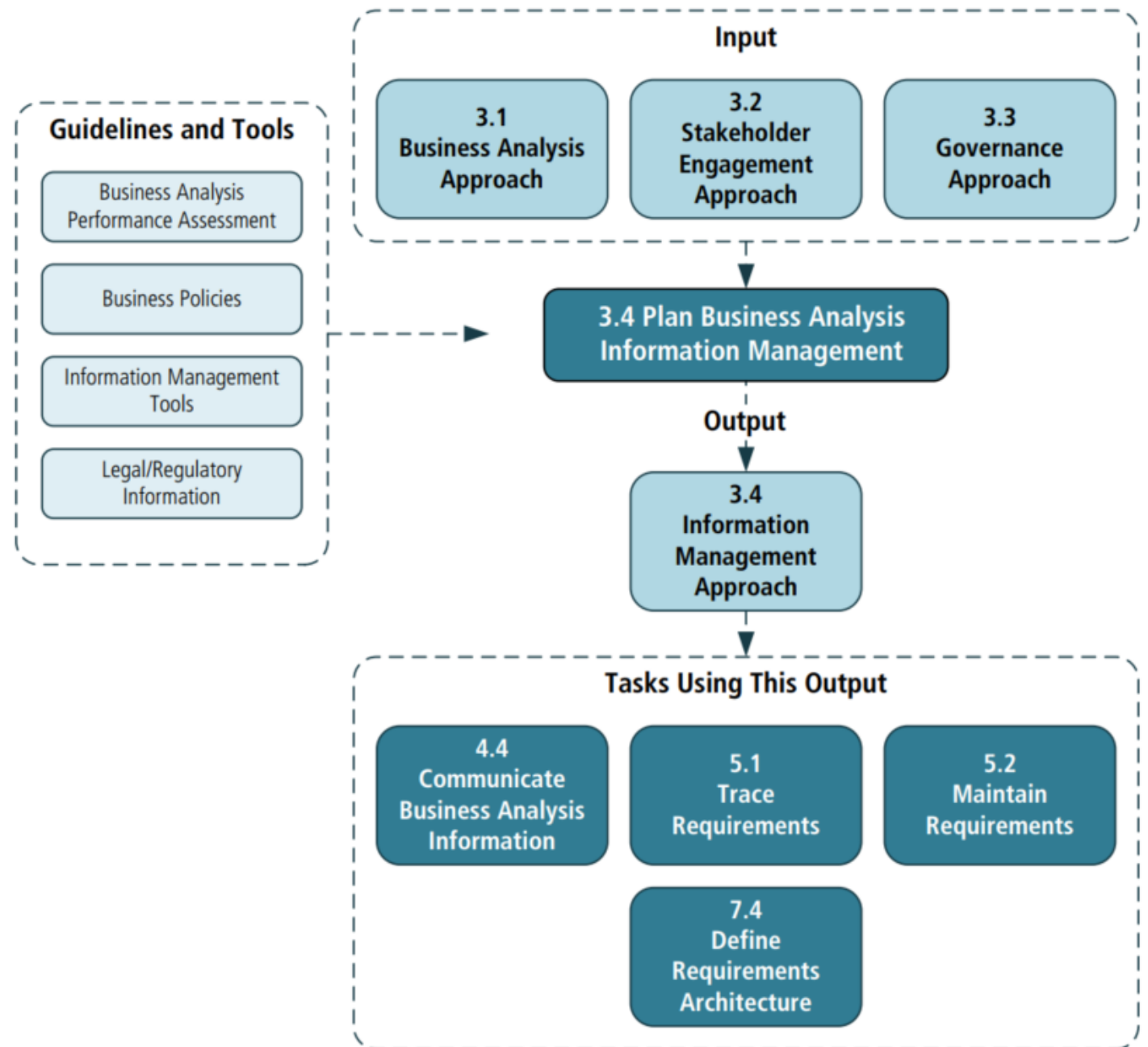
Plan Stakeholder Engagement Input/Output Diagram

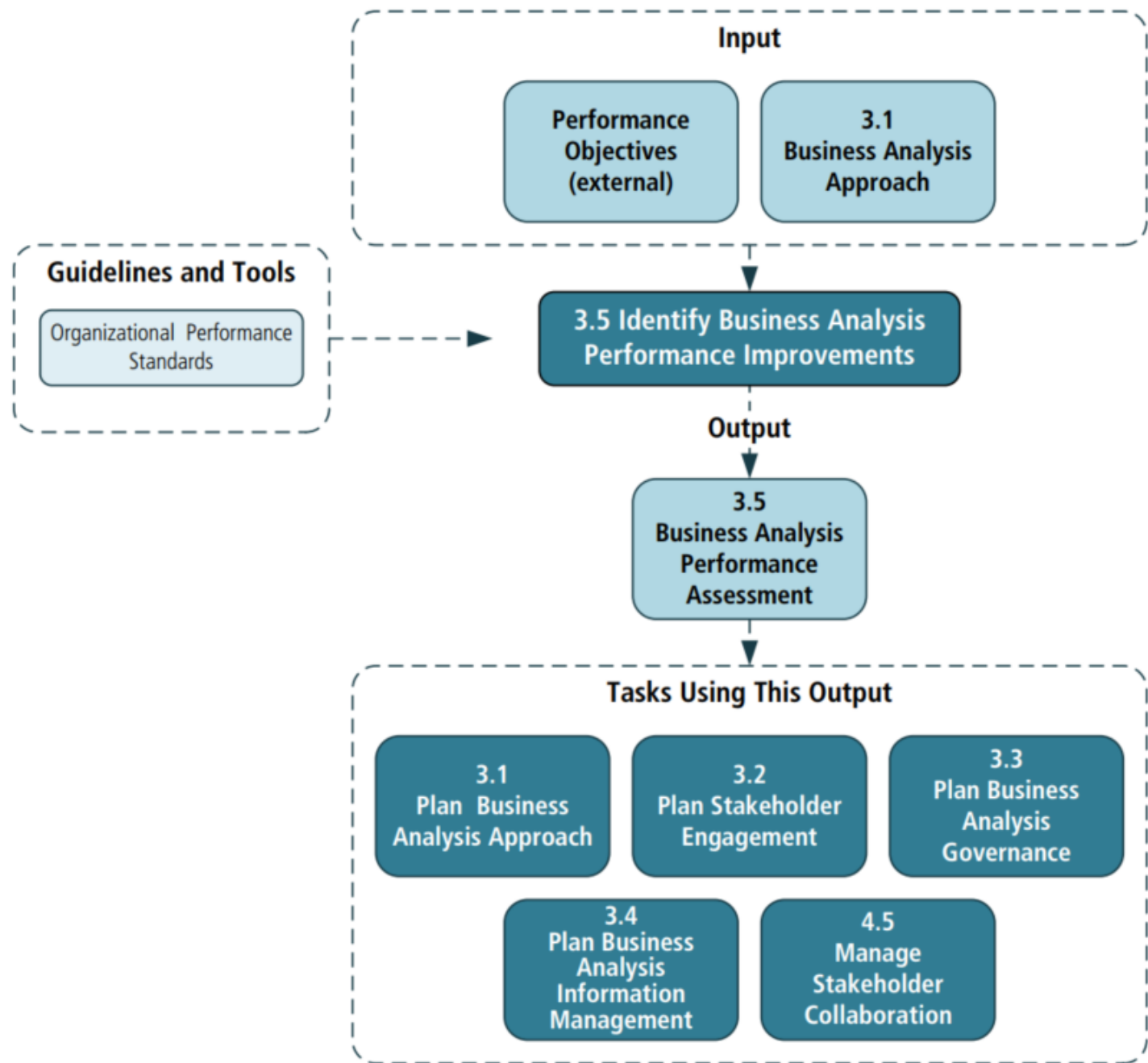

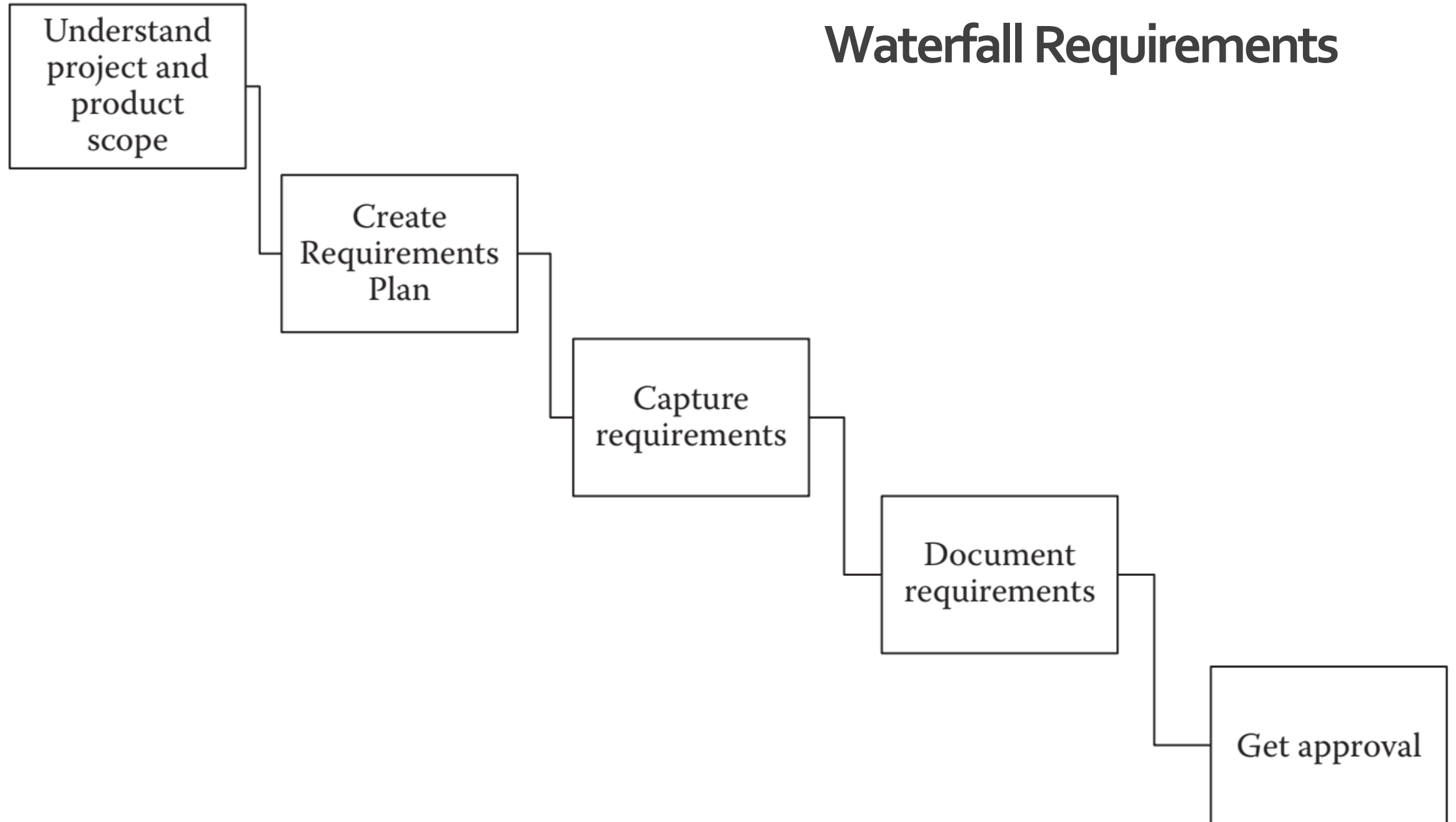

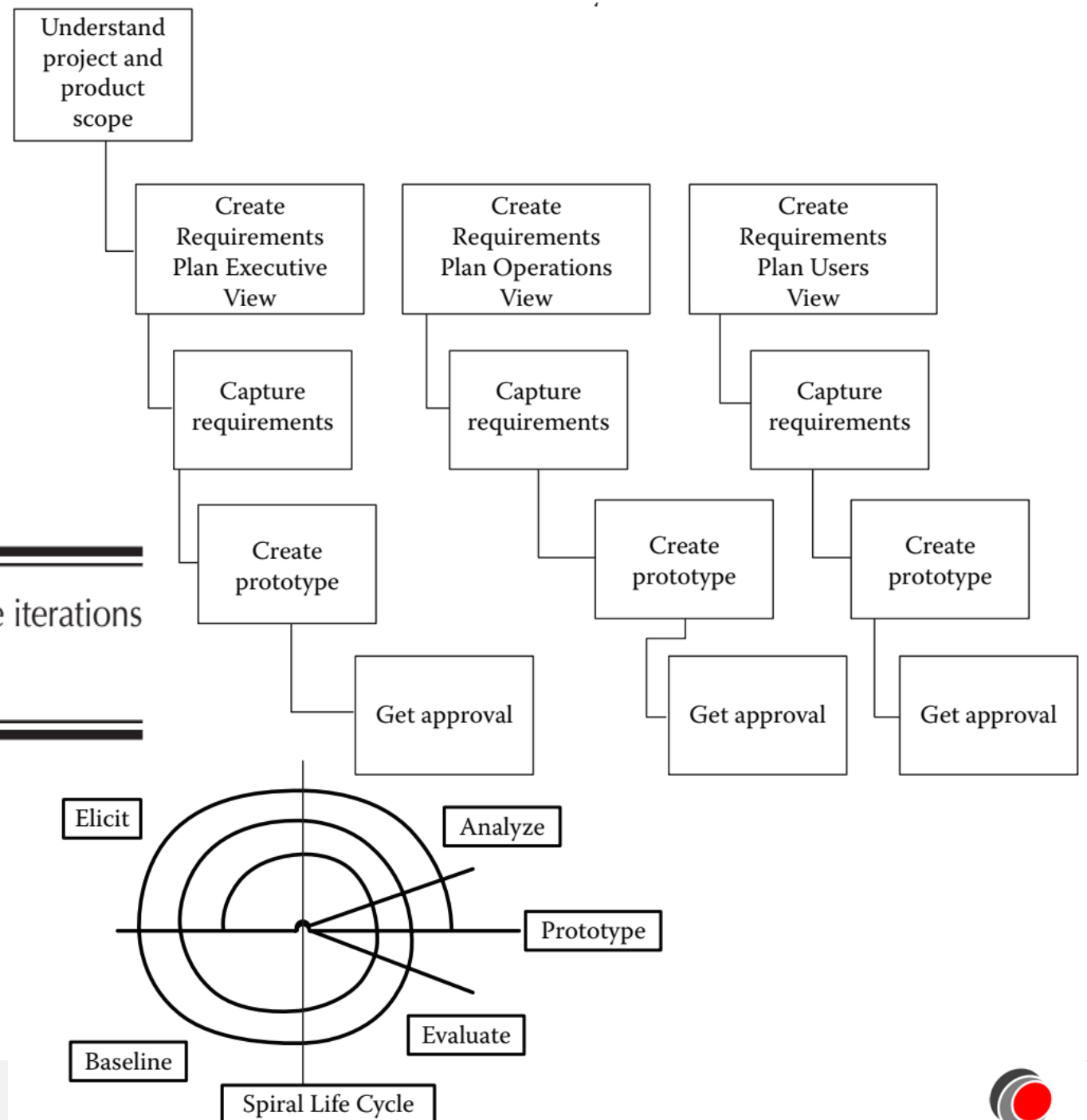


Waterfall Requirements



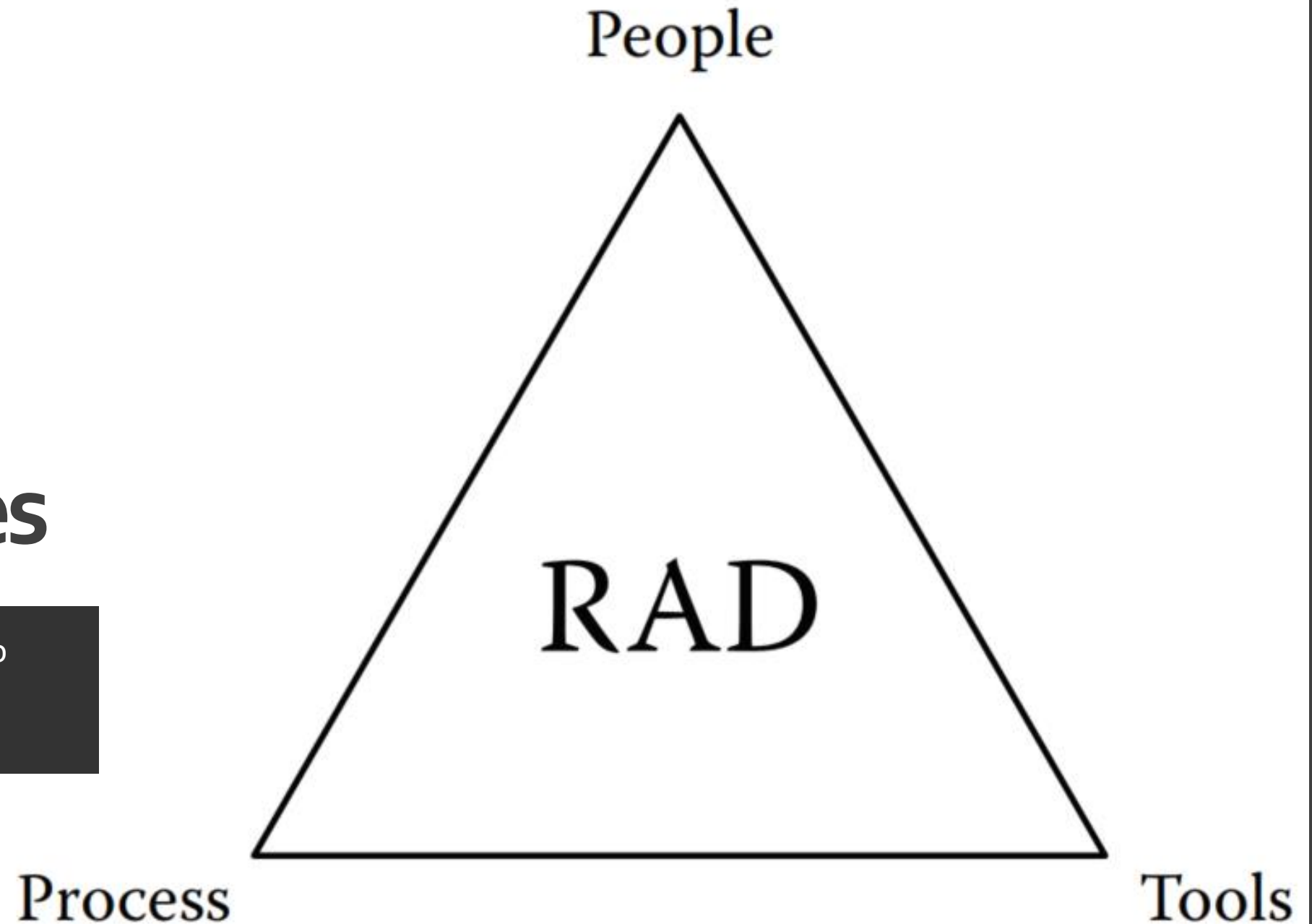
Iterative and Spiral Life Cycle

Without overall product vision and goals, each of the iterations will eventually move in uncontrollable directions.

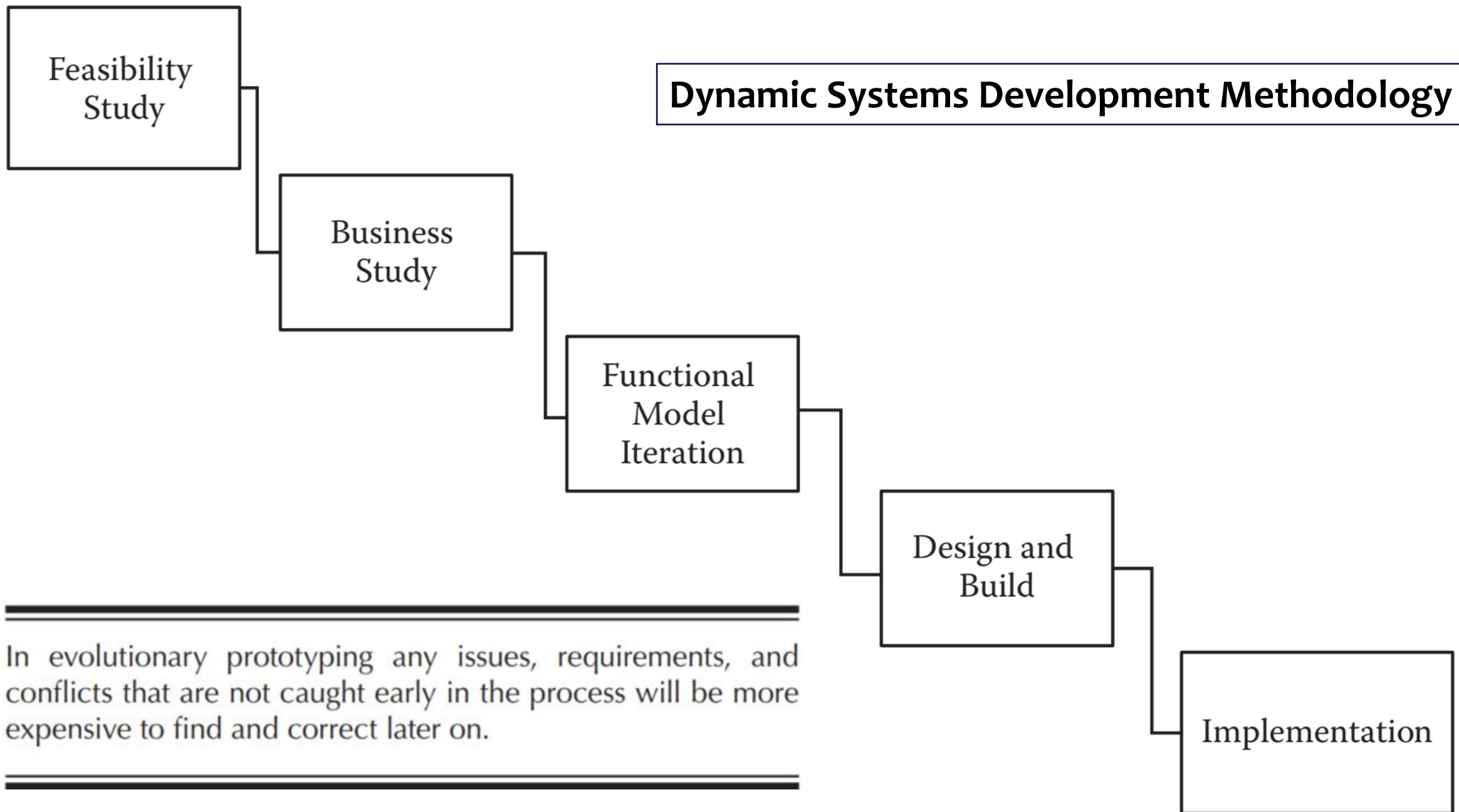
